- My Voice Survey (Aspirations Group) 4:20-4:50
- Arlene- Problem: all of the school doing the survey at once
 - Felt it needed a reason on why it is needed to be taken seriously
 - High percentage of questions were left unanswered
 - Felt there were too many questions
 - Kids get test tired
 - Maybe could have fewer amount of questions
 - Divided the questions in groups to look for questions where numbers go up & where numbers went down (3%)
- With: how does the number of students affect the data?
 - Burbank: 1% up or down is about 12 students- seems consistent
- Cara: Question 72- it is interpreted very differently between teachers and students so responses
 - Arlene:
 - Vickie: when students are clear what is expected it brings down stress
 - Chris: it is an unfair way to ask the question- it lays burden on faculty only place where students can give input- stress needs to be dealt with jointly with parents, teachers and staff so that high school experience can be enjoyable
 - School needs to devote extra time and effort to try to reduce stress level in high school
 - Burbank: Maybe need to make a focus group or ask the question "Where does your stress come from"
- Potts: Number 66- massive drop between freshman and sophomores- What happened?
 - o Number 44-
 - o Number 47- 29-30's
- Questions related to school atmosphere seem to drop down
- Karen: Belonging has the most questions that has gone down
 - Arlene: what does it mean for teachers to have fun?
- Leslie W: The point of these questions being vague is because it would take too much time for teachers to explain every detailed question

- Jessie: Some of these questions will not have any solutions/won't make a differencemaybe skip those questions or cut them out
 - Arlene: The questions give us a picture of what the kids feel
 - Kevin: Feels the survey needs an intro of why they are taking this survey/ who will be seeing it
 - Arlene: there were teachers who did talk about it
 - Vickie: would it be helpful to break the survey up between days
 - o Judy Mendleson: Can we change the number of questions?
 - Burbank: we cannot
 - Burbank: we need to narrow which ones we want to look at
 - Velschow:
- Chris: Stress the point that this is a great student body- everyone wants to do well
 - o Notes the high percentage in 'Confidence to take Action"
 - Burbank also noted #14 and other positives to keep working on
 - Vickie suggested to go back and compare the seniors responses versus when they were freshmen
 - Judith: #13 could be easy to change the answer to
 Very actionable
- Cara: are we trying to figure out action steps or?
 - We can come up with focus group questions
 - Burbank: Aspirations needs to look at #69 & see if we need the period or not & we will wait until next meeting to come up with questions
