**Wednesday, March 6**—This first workshop focuses on making a fitting, logical college list by understanding the different elements in the colleges: size, location, academics, cost, and more.

**Wednesday, March 13**—In the second workshop, students and parents will be in the role of admissions officers. They will evaluate 3 complete applications noting what seems important and interesting as well as what might be unnecessary or negative. Reading other students' work is very helpful guidance.

**Wednesday, March 20**—In the third workshop, students and parents will learn the specifics of the college application process with a focus on UCs, CSU, and Common App schools. As we move through the applications, SAT and ACT requirements, Personal Statements, and Letters of Recommendation will also be discussed.

**Wednesday, March 27**—The final workshop will be a quick review of the first three, suggestions for the summer, outlining a plan for senior year, and a brief introduction to financial aid and scholarships.
