

Everyone Needs an Account at the College Board


This is the same account that you use for PSAT, SAT, and previous AP scores.

Your College Board account holds all your information, you don't have to bubble your address and all that stuff on your answer sheets any more!!!




6 FILL OUT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The first time you enroll in an AP course in My AP, you'll need to fill out some registration information. It's important to provide accurate information. You only have to do this once.


Students Register Online for their AP classes

In every AP class you take, your teacher will give you a Join Code.

Registration is FREE.

You can't take an AP test unless you're registered in an AP Course.

You need to register even if you're not taking the test.




Students who want to take AP tests for courses they're not in also need Join Codes!!




1 SIGN IN

Sign in to myap.collegeboard.org using your College Board student account login. This is the same login you use to access your AP scores, PSAT/NMSQT® scores, or register for the SAT®. If you don't have a student account, click the [Sign up](#) link.




2 JOIN A COURSE

Click the **Join a Course or Exam** button. Before you do this, make sure you have the join code from your teacher. You'll need it to join a class section.



3 SUBMIT YOUR JOIN CODE

Enter the join code your teacher gave you and click **Submit**.



4 VERIFY COURSE INFORMATION

Make sure the information that comes up is for the course you're taking. If it is, click **Yes**.







If you have qualified for the Free or Reduced Lunch Program, your AP exam fees will be adjusted automatically in the system.


If you qualify later for the Free or Reduced Lunch Program, you can get the fees adjusted then.

LATE FEES

There are late fees for any changes made after the beginning of November.

This is WAY earlier than past years!



If you don't pay or arrange to pay by
November 1, no test will be ordered for you.

If you still want to take the test, you'll have
to pay the \$40 late fee!


So that's \$145 for regular, \$72 for reduced fees.



The rest of the payment is due February 14.

\$65 per test for regular fees

(If you have reduced fees, there is
no additional payment.)



If you don't complete the payment...

Your test will be cancelled.


You don't get to take the test

You don't get your \$40 deposit back.



You only have until February 14 to add additional tests

And remember, there's a \$40 Late Fee in addition to the regular test fees.



You can no longer take another student's test

In the past, a student could take the place of an absent student, but this is no longer allowed. The tests are specific to the students who ordered them.



What to bring on Testing Day


Your answer sheets and stickers will be there for you.

You bring: pencils, pens, water, extra layers of clothes, snacks, something to do if you finish early, and a calculator if your test allows one.



Seniors: sending scores to your college

In May or June, you will go to myap.collegeboard.org and send all of your scores to your college. It's easy and it's free. It won't affect your college admission, it will just allow you to skip classes and stuff when you get there.

You will get your score **online** in the first week of July, just like last year.
