



9TH GRADE CLASSES

ALL 9th graders must be enrolled in six 5-credit classes

Required Classes - "A-G" College Prep Classes

- 1. English
- 2. Life Skills/World Studies
- 3. Math
- 4. Science-Physics or Biology
- 5. Physical Education PE 1 or Dance
- 6. Elective Choice World Language, AVID, Drama, Engineering, Music, Support Class, Special Education



SCIENCE OPTIONS

9th graders have a choice of either Physics or Biology

Physics:

- 9th grade only
- Conceptual (hands-on) and Algebra-based
- Recommend co-enrollment in Algebra 1 or higher

Biology:

- Mixed 9th and 10th grade classes
- Hands-on NGSS based lab experiences

Placement in Science is **based on student/parent preference**, neither choice affects ability to take upper level science classes


