



Over-exposure = too light and 'washed out'.

**Under-exposure** = too dark.



Wide aperture: portraits, close ups.

**Small aperture:** group or team shots of people, landscapes and scenery.






## **Higher ISO setting:**

- · Greater the sensitivity to light
- · More noise

## Lower ISO setting:

- · Reduced sensitivity to light
- Less noise
